day by taking a cog-wheel train up to the Corcovado
Mountain to visit the iconic statue of Christ the Redeemer.
Later, proceed on a guided city tour of Rio. In the afternoon
take a cable car to the world-famous Sugar Loaf Mountain
which has become an iconic symbol of the city. Also visit the
famous Copacabana Beach. Tonight, enjoy Rio by Night as
you see the Ginga Tropical Show. Overnight at J W Marriott
Copacabana or similar in Rio de Janeiro. (B, IL, LD)

### DAY3

### Cusco – Peru

Today, after breakfast at the hotel, proceed to the airport, in your private vehicle, for your flight to Cusco – the gateway to Machu Pichu. On arrival into Cusco – meet your English-Speaking Guide who will take you to your private vehicle and transfer you to your hotel. At an elevation of 11200 Ft this is the undisputed archaeological capital of the Americas. Overnight at JW Marriott El Convento or similar in Cusco. (B,LD)

### DAY4

### Cusco. Machu Pichu

Today, after breakfast proceed to the Ollanta Train Station, with your private guide in your private vehicle, to board the scenic Vista Dome Train to Agua Calientes, also known as Machu Picchu Pueblo. Later, visit the ruins of Machu Pichu — standing 2,430 m above sea-level, in the middle of a tropical mountain forest, in an extraordinarily beautiful setting. It was probably the most amazing urban creation of the Inca Empire. Later, return to Cusco. Overnight at JW Marriott El Convento or similar in Cusco. (B,LL, LD)

### DAY5

### Flight to Lima

Today, after breakfast, proceed in your private vehicle to the airport for your flight to Lima – the capital of Peru. On arrival meet you English Speaking Guide and proceed on a city tour. Visit the modern and colonial parts of Lima, known as The City of Kings. Visit the districts of Miraflores and San Isidro, passing by a pre-Inca sacred place, before exploring the Historic Center.

Overnight at J W Marriott Lima or similar in Lima. (B,LL, ID)



### DAY6

### Lima. Day at Leisure or Optional Nazca Lines

Today, after breakfast the day is at leisure. You can explore this charming city on your own OR you can opt for an optional tour to see the mystical Nazca Lines. Drive south along the Pacific Coast to Paracas bay to board your flight that will take you over the incredible Nazca lines, located on the plain of the same name. See many geoglyphs representing stylized animals and plants, scattered among a great many lines, trapeziums, triangles and spirals cut into the earth and preserved for around 2,000 years.

Overnight at J W Marriott Lima or similar in LIma. (B, ID)





### DAY7

Fly to Puerto Iguazu.

Today, after breakfast, proceed in your private vehicle to the airport for your flight to Iguazu. Iguazu is famous for its stunning falls, a total of 275 waterfalls make up the Iguazu Falls, which are the widest and most imposing waterfalls on earth. Later you have some free time to explore the city on your own.

Overnight in Iguazu Grand Hotel or similar. (B, LD)

### DAY8


Iguazu Falls. Visit Iguazu Falls from Argentinean side.

Today, after breakfast visit the Argentinean side of the Iguazu Falls. Start with a short train ride that leads to the trails. Later a walk along the catwalks, some 1200 meters over the islands, takes you to enjoy the most spectacular sight- the Devil's Throat Fall. Today, also ride on trucks that take you through the National Park and marvel at the great vegetation. Later, enjoy a magnificent boat ride at the falls.

### DAY9

Visit Iguazu Falls from Brazilian Side. Fly to Buenos Aires

Today, visit the Brazilian side of the falls. Walk along a narrow 1,500m. path and along with the catwalk that goes very close to the bottom of the Devil's Throat, from where you will enjoy breathtaking views over the Brazilian side of the falls. Later proceed to the airport for your flight to Buenos Aires. the capital of Argentina. On arrival meet you English Speaking Guide and proceed to your hotel.

Overnight at Intercontinental Buenos Aires. (B, ID)


### DAY10

Buenos Aires. Guided Tour, Tango Lesson, Show & Dinner

Today, after breakfast, enjoy a private guided city tour of this beautiful city. See the symbol of the city: the obelisk on avenida 9 de Julio, visit Plaza de Mayo and Plaza San Martín. Drive through the neighborhoods like La Boca, San Telmo and Recoleta. Later in the evening you will experience the glamorous Tango Show with dinner. Overnight at Intercontinental Buenos Aires. (B, IL ID)







### DAY11

### Amazon Eco Park

Today, after breakfast, meet your English-speaking guide and proceed to the airport in your private vehicle. Board your flight to Manaus – the gateway to the Brazilian Amazon. On arrival at Manaus you will be met by expert naturalists. Proceed by jeep to the river and then board your boat and travel to your lodge – located in the heart of the Amazon.

On an exciting Night Tour on a canoe appreciate the sounds of the jungle at night, with the possibility to spot small alligators (or other nightly creatures). Alligators are spotted because their eyes shine like small red lights. Once the alligator is spotted by the guide's spotlight, he will try to catch a small alligator with his own hands and bring it on to the canoe, and a brief explanation of their habitat follows. The alligator will then be safely released back to the river.

Travel on boat or motorized canoe, accompanied by a Bilingual guide to learn about the traditions and customs of local Amazonians ("natives").

### Bid farewell.


